Will's afternoon session will explore practical steps that parents can take to help their children deal well with the rigours of growing up in and out of school and will conclude with a Q & A session where you are invited to express your concerns and clarify your queries regarding your role as a parent and guardian of your child's learning.

Will Ord has trained teachers in over a thousand primary & secondary schools all over the UK during the last 13 years.
