Educational Qualifications

The successful candidate will be sufficiently qualified that they can legally be employed by St. Lawrence College as a full-time teacher. It is highly likely that they will be a graduate of a Greek university and will certainly possess perfect skills in all aspects of the Greek language. The successful applicant will also have very strong English communication skills – both written and oral.

Teaching Experience

The successful candidate will likely have at least two years' experience of teaching Greek to children. Experience of a British educational system would be preferred but is not essential for this position.

Personal Characteristics

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a proven record of professional reliability, punctuality and excellent attendance record in previous employment. In addition to being a native speaker of Greek, the successful candidate's spoken and written English standards will be excellent. The successful candidate will be able to work closely with colleagues, will be able to show initiative and enthusiasm in their teaching. The successful candidate will possess an awareness of and a positive attitude towards British educational values and have a flexibility and enthusiasm for the methodology of British schools. Our new colleague will completely understand that while this is a position to teach Greek – it is so within the context of a British school which, like all British schools places great emphasis on pastoral as well as academic care for pupils. The successful candidate will show a willingness to promote individually and as part of a close staff body, those academic and pastoral values.

Child Protection

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a suitability to take up such a teaching position in the context of child protection in line with the expectations of British schools throughout the UK and the wider world. This will include cooperation with the school in the procurement of background checks as appropriate.
