SUMMER SCHOOL REGULATIONS

Please note that all pupils registered in the Summer School programme are required to follow staff instructions and are expected to demonstrate respectful and appropriate behaviour at all times.

Any pupil who does not meet the school's behavioural expectations, or who is considered unable to meet these expectations, may be required to withdraw from the Summer School programme.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SWIMMERS

- On the days when pupils have swimming, they are advised to eat a good breakfast at home and only have a light snack, if necessary, before their lesson.
- All swimmers must take a shower before and after swimming.
- Diving into the pool is absolutely forbidden unless it is part of the swimming lesson.
- Swimmers with open wounds, sores or skin infections are not permitted in the pool at any time.
- No rough play, running or shoving etc. in the pool area.
- Inflatable devices or swimming aids i.e. armbands, inflatable rings, swimming suits with inflatable devices are not permitted.
- Chewing gum is absolutely forbidden.
- Pupils must be quiet around the pool.
- No use of kickboards or pull buoys other than for their intended use.
- Swimming is prohibited for female pupils during their monthly period.
- Sunbathing oil is prohibited for safety reasons, but waterproof creams can be used as sun protection.
- **DRESS CODE:** swimmers are required to wear a bathing cap, goggles, swimsuits (no cut-offs, gym/boxer shorts are allowed). It is also compulsory to wear flip flops when walking in the pool area. Swimmers must also have a towel, a bath robe and an athletic bag.

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Certificates from a cardiologist and a dermatologist, or a certificate from a paediatrician, are required.
- No swimmers will be allowed to enter the pool without providing the school with these certificates.

ADDITIONAL SWIMMING POOL AREA RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No food, drink or tobacco products anywhere in the swimming pool area.
- Nothing must be thrown around the pool area.

SCHOOL BUS REGULATIONS

In order for all pupils to have a safe and pleasant ride on the bus, pupils must follow the school's rules of conduct. The bus is an extension of the classroom and our school rules of Ready, Respectful & Safe apply on the bus in the same way as they do in school.

It is the primary responsibility of the driver to transport pupils safely to and from school. The driver's attention must be on the road and traffic conditions and not on pupils' behaviour. School officials will handle any misconduct so as to ensure the safety of all pupils travelling on the bus.

Pupils therefore must:

- sit in their assigned seats at all times. Seats are assigned by the bus monitor.
- comply with the instructions of the bus monitor, who is ultimately responsible for the pupil's safety and well-being
- not stand or walk in the aisles or obstruct them in any way i.e. with bags etc.
- remain properly seated and wear seat-belts throughout the duration of the bus trip
- talk quietly; the driver needs to concentrate to safely drive the bus
- not fight, shout, or use obscene language
- not throw objects inside or outside of the bus
- not eat or drink (this includes chewing gum) on school buses at any time. This rule protects pupils that have food allergies and anaphylaxis, prevents choking, and maintains bus cleanliness.
- not use mobile phones or cameras as recording devices while on board the bus.

The cost of any damage attributed to them is borne by the parents. (Pupils who vandalize a bus will be held responsible for the cost of repairs and may lose riding privileges.)

The seriousness of any of the above offences may warrant immediate suspension for a period of time after being investigated and reviewed by the school's Management Committee.

CHANGES IN THE DAILY BUS ROUTINE

Any request for a change of bus on a particular day cannot be accommodated.

Parents wishing to collect their child/children from the school on a particular afternoon **must** do the following:

This will eliminate last minute confusion, consequent delays and ascertain the safety of the child/children.
